A Senior Advisor to DCI, Mr. Davenport leads the firm's growing government affairs practice. His professional career spans over 30 years of public policy and advocacy campaigns both inside and outside The Beltway, including representation of foreign country interests in Latin America, Europe, and Asia. He has represented dozens of Fortune 500 clients in the policy areas of homeland security, technology, financial services, foreign affairs, gaming, taxes, transportation, and intellectual property.

An early 2014 supporter of then candidate, Donald Trump, Mr. Davenport has held several political roles for all three of the Trump Presidential Campaigns. Most recently, Mr. Davenport was the 2024 Trump Campaign Convention Team Manager for the historic Republican National Convention in Milwaukee, WI. Additionally, in the closing weeks of the 2024 Campaign, Mr. Davenport was a member of the Florida Campaign Headquarters' Election Integrity Operation. Following Election Day 2024, Mr. Davenport oversaw the Campaign's Electoral College State Whip Team to officially certify President-Elect Trump's Election on December 17, 2024.

From 2000 until 2010, Mr. Davenport served as the founding partner of DCI Associates, at that time the Federal Government Affairs division of DCI. In this role, Mr. Davenport provided strategic counsel to corporations, foreign countries, and non-profit entities seeking legislative and public affairs solutions on Capitol Hill and within the Executive Branch Administrative Agencies.

From 1996 until 2000, Mr. Davenport served as Director of Government Relations for GTECH Corporation (now Brightstar Corporation), the largest manufacturer and supplier of state-government run lottery systems in more than 80 jurisdictions, worldwide. Additionally, Mr. Davenport represented GTECH in its membership and participation in various political and governmental associations such as the Democrat and Republican Governors' Associations, Democrat and Republican Congressional Campaign Committees and numerous other political and governmental organizations, across the country.

Mr. Davenport's public affairs career began in 1992 as a research associate at BMSK Public Affairs. During his tenure at BMSK, Mr. Davenport supported the firm's public affairs activities on behalf of such clients as Donald Trump, American Airlines, The Revlon Corporation, and several countries, abroad. In 1993-1994, Mr. Davenport served as a Washington, D.C. travel aide to former U.S. President Richard Nixon.
